







CITY OF PORT WASHINGTON RECYCLING INSTRUCTIONS

Recycling Rules:

- Place **BLUE** or **CLEAR** recycling bag and recycling bundles at the curb by 7:00 AM on your collection day. **Garbage and recycling carts will begin April 1, 2009. Please put all carts at the curb by 7:00 a.m.**
- Glass, plastic, aluminum and bi-metal containers may be **mixed together** in a **BLUE** or **CLEAR** recycling bag that can be purchased at retail outlets in Port Washington or place in recycling carts.
- Newspapers, magazines, and corrugated cardboard may be placed in brown grocery bags or tied in bundles and placed curbside, adjacent to the **BLUE** or **CLEAR** recycling bag or place in recycling carts.

Recycling Collection Schedule:

Collection will be on the same day as your garbage collection on alternate weeks (Please review recycling calendar on other side). All recyclables must be placed at the curb by 7:00 AM.

Other bottles marked: 1 PETE 2 HDPE	RINSE CLEAN Remove and discard lids Crush Bottles	Plastic oil bottles, yogurt & ice cream containers, food containers, Styrofoam, plastic cups & plastic grocery bags (film), hard plastic (toys, pails, etc.) medicine bottles & syringes
NEWSPAPER & MAGAZINES 	Newspapers, magazines, and other clean paper products such as office paper, cracker and cereal boxes.	Tie with string or twine in both directions or place in paper grocery bags. Bundles no larger than 8" in height. (Dumpster available at Street Yard)	Contaminated Paper
CORRUGATED CARDBOARD 	Larger Boxes	Flatten Boxes. Cut to 3' x 3' pieces. Tie in bundles or place in cart. (Dumpster available at Street Yard)	Detergent Boxes
APPLIANCES/WHITE GOODS	Washing machine, stoves, freezers, refrigerators, grills, snow blowers, etc.	Call Arrow Disposal at 262-284-1166 or	Port Recycling at 262-284-4060
SPECIAL PICKUP	Furniture (Larger than 3' x 5'), etc	Call Veolia for Special Pickup at 1-800-387-0949
