**VITA Tax Assistance**

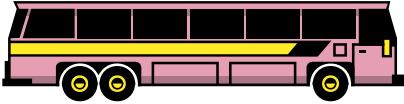

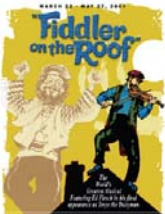
### Trip News

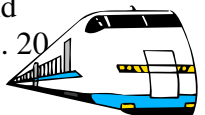
